In support for "Flash Flood 2024 Affected People in the Eastern Region", November 16, 2024

MAAWS HAS PROVIDED 500 HYGIENE KITS

MAAWS started the Water and Sanitation Program in 2008 in the wake of the devastation from the 2007 South Asian Floods. With your help, we have installed 287 arsenic-free tube wells and 600 sanitary latrines (ground toilets) in Bangladesh (as of January 2015), primarily in the Earpur project site in Noakhali. After the 2024 devastating flash flood in the eastern side of Bangladesh, MAAWS started with dry food support as an emergency response. A hygiene kit was another emergency requirement for the flood-affected people.

November 16, 2024, was a significant and impactful one! The distribution of 500 hygiene kits under the project "Support for Flash Flood 2024 Affected People in the Eastern Region". The presence of local government authorities (LGA) like the Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) and Social Development Officer emphasizes the importance community support collaboration in times of disaster recovery activities by MAAWS.



EACH KIT INCLUDES:

- 4 Antibacterial Bathing Soap (75 gram)
- 1 Bottle of Antiseptic Liquid (500 ml)
- 1 Bottle of Calamine Lotion (100 ml)
- 1 Pair of Rubber Sandals
- 1 Bleaching Powder (500 gram)
- 1 Packet of Washing Powder (500 gram)
- 10 Oral Saline
- 2 Toothbrushes
- 1 Toothpaste (45 gram)
- 1 Savalon Antiseptic Cream (60 gram)
- 1 16 Liter Bucket with Lid
